DIY SUMMER GAMES With tin cans:

Peel the stickers off, pick up the spray paint and make the cans fun and colourful, and of course you can have kids decorate them with paint or stickers to really jazz them up.

- Ten-Tin Bowling: You can stack them or just lay them out. Use rocks, a ball, even bean bags! Bowling is classic! I don't care who you are...knocking stuff down is always fun!
- Tin-Telephone Game: Grab two cans, pop holes in the bottom with a nail and a hammer. String through some string and tie notes to keep them from falling out the holes. Boom! We have a old school favourite, tin-telephone- ready to tell secrets to each other all summer long!
- Tin-Planter: Make sure to pop some holes in the bottom to drain the water! Let the kids decorate the cans. Then plant the seeds and watch them grow!
- Tin Stilts: Make some holes on both sides towards the bottom (which will become the top!) string through some rope or twine and tie a knot. FYI: it was a lot easier to walk on hard ground instead of grass!
